Kitten College: Small Program, Huge Impact (45min)

This presentation discusses the programmatic development of the Kitten College at the Animal Welfare League of Arlington in Arlington, VA. Shelter and rescue staff and administrators are best suited to attend this presentation. Structure, foster recruitment and support as well as resource saving tips are covered. All resources discussed in this presentation will be given to the host in an editable version on a thumb drive.



Taking the Fear Out of Bottle Feeding and Basic Kitten Care (90min)

This is our most popular training course and is geared towards veterinary staff, fosters, potential fosters and animal care staff. It follows the recently updated guidelines released by UC Davis's Koret Shelter Medicine Program in August 2023. We encourage groups to invite anyone interested kitten care to attend this presentation, including folks outside of your rescue or shelter.

Advancements in Neonatal Kitten Care

This presentation is a brief version of "Taking the Fear Our of Bottle Feeding and Basic Kitten Care". It is the live version of the popular Maddie's Fund Webinar of the same name, and it best directed towards high functioning fosters and veterinary staff.
